DAY 1

GOD IS HOLY

The holiness of God is the foundation of all His attributes.

READINGS:

Isaiah 6:1-7; 1 Samuel 2:2; Hebrews 7:26

QUESTIONS TO PONDER:

1. What other words are similar to the word “holy”?
2. How is God’s holiness described by Isaiah? Why did Isaiah react in such a manner?
3. How should we respond to the holiness of God? How will this affect the way we live especially during this time of crisis?

PRAYER: We bow down before You, O Lord. We are unworthy to be in Your presence but You have chosen to reveal Yourself to us. Thank You for letting us live through this crisis knowing we need to fully depend on You. In Jesus’ name, Amen.



DAY 2

GOD IS ETERNAL

*The Lord is alive and active forevermore.
This earth will end but He is eternal.*

READINGS:

Deuteronomy 33:26-27; Revelation 1:7-8

QUESTIONS TO PONDER:

1. What are the implications of the eternity of God versus the mortality of man?
2. If Jesus is the Alpha and Omega (A-Z in the English alphabet), how will this change our perspective about things happening in our world right now?

PRAYER: Eternal God, we come before You now as mere mortal people. Let us trust in You. By faith in You, we can have eternal life through Your Son, Jesus. In this difficult time we have nothing to fear. We are in Your eternal arms, Amen.



DAY 3

GOD IS JUST

*The only truly just and fair person is our Lord God.
His judgments are perfect.*

READINGS:

Daniel 6:15-24; Psalm 7:8-11; Romans 9:14-15;
Revelation 22:12

QUESTIONS TO PONDER:

1. How can we trust God in a seemingly unfair world?
Can we say we get what we deserve?
2. In what ways can we proclaim God's justice to
others during this crisis?

PRAYER: Our just Judge and God, we entrust the outcomes of our lives, both now and the future, to Your perfect will. May we live to strive to be pleasing in Your sight. In Jesus' name, Amen.



DAY 4

GOD IS SOVEREIGN

The presidents, rulers, and politicians of this day will not rule for all time and do not have total authority.

READINGS:

Exodus 9:13-18; Daniel 7:14; Luke 8:27-33

QUESTIONS TO PONDER:

1. Why do we value control? What does the CoViD-19 tell us about what we can control as humans?
2. What does the sovereignty of God mean to us in the midst of all this? How can we learn to trust Him through it?

PRAYER: Dear Lord, things are out of control in the entire world right now. We are afraid. Help us remember that You are sovereign. Your will be done in Your time, Amen.



DAY 5

GOD IS FAITHFUL

*People come and go and break their promises.
But God fulfills His promises always.*

READINGS:

Genesis 9:12-17; Psalm 89:1-2;
1 John 1:9; 1 Corinthians 1:9

QUESTIONS TO PONDER:

1. How will the faithfulness of God lead us through this time of trial?
2. What is the best way to minister God's faithfulness to those who may desperately need it?

PRAYER: We praise You, dear Lord, for You are ever faithful. May we rest in Your eternal promises during these times of uncertainty. We know You love us and will protect us as Your children. In the mighty name of Your Son, Jesus, Amen.
